# Technical Bulletin 63388



Emergency Dialing with Unregistered Polycom<sup>®</sup> SoundPoint<sup>®</sup> IP, SoundStation<sup>®</sup> IP, and VVX<sup>®</sup> Phones

This technical bulleting describes an issue with emergency dialing as it relates to unregistered Polycom SoundPoint IP, SoundStation IP, and VVX phones running certain software releases.

This information applies to SoundPoint IP, SoundStation IP, and VVX phones running SIP software versions 3.2.0 or later.

### **Symptom**

If a phone's SIP lines are not registered with a call server, and the Emergency Call Routing Feature is enabled (by configuring the dialplan.routing.emergency.x.value and

dialplan.routing.emergency.x.server.y parameters) dialing the configured emergency number will <u>only</u> work if you use on-hook dialing and when URL Dialing is enabled.

You will not be able to dial the emergency number (using either on-hook or off-hook dialing) if URL Dialing is disabled.

## Workaround

URL dialing must be enabled and the user must use on-hook dialing when attempting to place an emergency call when the phone is not registered and this feature is in use.

#### **Status**

Polycom will addressed this issue in the subsequent software releases scheduled for early 2011. If you need to enable this feature before the scheduled maintenance releases, please contact Polycom VoIP Product Support.
