Description

The Link 150 system has an internal modem built into line number one on the Master Control unit. The modem allows SpectraLink remote access for troubleshooting and certification. The line that is used for the modem must be set up properly.

Setup

The line connected to the modem in the SpectraLink system must be a digital line from the Executone PBX. It should be programmed similar to how the lines for the Wireless Telephones are programmed. There are a few changes that will need to be done. The following detail the programming changes that **MUST BE SET** for the modem line:

1. Hands Free CO needs to be set as Yes. This change is made in the Systems Setting section of the programming.
2. Keys 1, 2, and 3 should have the LCR (Least Call Routing) value set at 300 / 100.
